Vincent is an Irish architect, is the founding partner and lead architect of Hong Kong-based ALT Design & Construction, established in 2014. Inspired by an early apprenticeship with his father, a master stonemason who crafted commissions for the British Royal Family, Vincent trained in architecture and graduated as valedictorian. His international career includes time at OMA under Rem Koolhaas and serving as a lead designer on Prada's landmark projects, including the Prada Transformer and Fondazione Prada, plus contributions to Taipei Performing Arts Center.

Moving to Hong Kong, he led the design and construction of Prince Plaza, a 100,000m<sup>2</sup> mixed-use tower in Shenzhen, before founding ALT Design & Construction at 28.

The firm specializes in luxury lifestyle properties across Asia, beachfront villas, ski resorts, hotels and retail, and has completed over 60 bespoke villas from Lombok to Hokkaido.

Vincent and ALT have earned Perspective A&D awards (silver and gold for two Japanese residential projects) and The Architecture Community Awards (Architect and House of the Year for two other Japanese projects) and have been featured in The Financial Times, Prestige HK and Home Journal.
